Björn's focus includes creating a world-class consumer-focused franchise beverage system that strengthens the network and builds capabilities to drive advantage for today and tomorrow in a franchise-centric organization.

Björn believes in developing high-performing teams through passion, purpose, and fun with a service-first mindset. He consistently demonstrates the ability to work across developed, developing, and emerging geographies to meet the needs of customers and consumers. Passionate about environmental and human sustainability, Björn led PepsiCo's initiatives to become the first big beverage brand to become 100% rPET and to reduce sugar across the portfolio in critical markets across Europe.
